Programs for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities

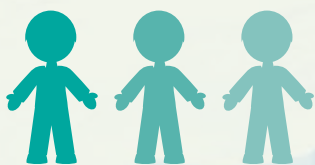
Support services for people who have been sexually abused as children
